

## Using **MCKAL** MP866, MP867, MP867-IR or MP901 for SmartCard and Singapore NETS cashcard

### IMPORTANT NOTE:

- i. *NETS cashcard is a NETS proprietary implementation. Hence, to read the cashcard transaction log, you can either use (a) NETS online website or (b) NETS E-Wallet application.*
- ii. *For support of NETS online website or NETS E-Wallet application, please contact NETS Singapore.*
- iii. ***MCKAL** is not the owner of NETS cashcard, its online website or NETS E-Wallet and is not obliged to provide technical support for NETS cashcard, its online website or NETS E-Wallet.*

This guide will guide you through the **additional** setup of the necessary drivers on your Windows system for using SmartCard and Singapore NETS cashcard.

### **A** What you need

1. **MCKAL** MP866, MP867, MP867 with IR or MP901
2. 1 valid working NETS cashcard

### **B** Setting up your PC/Laptop with the drivers

1. Drivers (MP866/MP867/MP867-IR/MP901) must have been installed on your Windows system. If not, please proceed to download the relevant User Guides and drivers from <http://www.mckal.com/support.php> .
2. Complete the installation as instructed before proceeding with Part C.

## C Reading your CashCard



Note the direction of the cashcard – chip should face up

### Option 1 – Using the Cashcard offline (with NETS E-Wallet)

1. Download NETS E-Wallet from <http://www.mckal.com/download/NETSE-Wallet230Full.zip>
2. Run **NETSE-Wallet230Full.zip** to install NETS E-Wallet.
3. Download <http://www.mckal.com/download/McKALCashcardReaderUpdate.zip>
4. Unzip **McKALCashcardReaderUpdate.zip**
5. Run **McKALCashcardReaderUpdate.exe**
6. Launch “NETS E-Wallet” and click login (as guest and no password needed).
7. Go to “Transaction History” tab → “CashCard Detail” for your transaction log.

### Option 2 – Using the Cashcard functions online with NETS website

1. Go to [www.nets.com.sg](http://www.nets.com.sg)
2. Select “NETS CASHCARD”
3. Select “NETS CashCard Online Services” to access your cashcard transactions.
4. IMPORTANT: You must allow and install the Java API when prompted.

## Troubleshooting MCKAL MP866, MP867, MP867-IR or MP901 for SmartCard and Singapore NETS cashcard on NETS Online Website

### General

#### Problem Description

1. Cannot detect cashcard

#### Possible Cause

1. Cashcard is inserted incorrectly.

#### Resolution



Note the direction of the cashcard – chip should face up

### General

#### Problem Description

1. Required files cannot be found or
2. Restrictions to download and auto-install SmartCardAPI.jar

#### Possible Cause

1. The following files are not in the respective directories.
  - a) C:\Windows\system32\scard.dll
  - b) C:\Windows\system32\scd1132.dll
  - c) C:\Program Files\Java\jre6\lib\ext\SmartCardAPI.jar

#### Resolution

1. Download <http://www.mkal.com/download/NETSOnlineDLLAPI.zip>.
2. Unzip and copy the 3 files to their respective directories.

## On Windows XP

### Problem Description

1. Error messages when viewing cashcard transactions or checking cashcard balance.

### Possible Cause

1. Insufficient administrator rights.

### Resolution

1. Assign Administrator rights to your user account.
2. Set your User Account Control (UAC) to **never notify**.
  - a) Go to "Control Panel"
  - b) Click on "All Control Panel items"
  - c) Click on "Action Center"
  - d) On the top left, click on "User Account Control settings"
  - e) Set to "never notify"

## On Windows Vista

### Problem Description

1. Cannot download of "SmartCardAPI.jar" by Java to "java\lib\ext" directory.

### Possible Cause

1. New feature on Windows Vista - "User Account Control" turned on by default that prevents the download from completing.

### Resolution

1. Assign Administrator rights to your user account.
2. Follow these steps to turn off "User Account Control" on Vista
  - a) Click "Window" > "Control Panel" > "User Accounts"
  - b) If there are multiple accounts, please click on the correct account that you will be using
  - c) Click "Turn User Account Control on or off"
  - d) Uncheck "Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer" > Click "OK"
  - e) When prompted to restart, click "Restart Now"
  - f) UAC will be disabled after restart.
3. After restart, you may try to read your cashcard via NETS online website again.
